

Personal Information Protection Act Notice

Dear Sir/Madam:

The following information is provided for your reference by China Airlines Co., Ltd. (hereafter referred to as "CAL") in accordance with Article 8, Section 1, and Article 9, Section 1, of the *Personal Information Protection Act* (hereafter referred to as "PIPA").

1. Purpose of information collection:

For hosting the China Airlines 60th Anniversary: A Fresh Start Vintage Photo Event.

2. Classification of personal information collected:

The types of personal information gathered by CAL include but are not limited to: personal identification, attributes, education, qualification, technical and other specialties, and other (the types of personal information are based on the *specific purpose and the classification of personal information of the Personal Information Protection Act* issued by the Ministry of Justice.) Examples:

2.1 Name.

2.2 Home telephone number, mobile number.

2.3 E-mail address.

2.4 Contact address.

3. The time period, target, area and usage of the personal information:

3.1 Time period: For the period of this event, and for the length of time that the information must be retained by law.

3.2 Target: CAL and its subsidiaries, overseas branches, as well as agencies with investigative powers and competent authorities.

3.3 Area: Regions where the above subjects are located.

3.4 Usage: In writing, electronic document, telephone, fax, as well as automated machines or other non-automated formats that conform to the law.

4. Under Article 3 of PIPA, you may exercise the following rights over your personal information obtained by CAL:

a. Rights that you may exercise with CAL:

i. Inquiry, request for review, or request for duplication of personal information. By law, a fee may be charged by CAL to recoup any necessary costs.

ii. Request to supplement or correct the personal information, though a suitable reason and facts of the matter should be provided.

iii. Request to discontinue the collection, processing or use of personal information by CAL, or request its deletion. CAL may deny your request if the personal information is required for the conduct of its business, fulfillment of contractual obligations, or for compliance with other laws and regulations.

b. Method for exercising of rights: Requests can be made in writing or through the customer service hotline.

5. Rights and interests impacted by non-provision of personal information (applicable when personal information is collected directly from the subject):

Where your personal information must be collected, processed or used by CAL for the above reasons, if the relevant personal information cannot be provided then their processing may be delayed or canceled, resulting in further delays.
